Environmental Photojournalism Training – Invitation to nominate participants

Nai-Supporting Open Media in Afghanistan, the Center for International Journalists (CIJ) and the United Nations Environment Programme (UNEP) are inviting Kabul-based Print and TV Media Outlets to nominate interested photographers and journalists to participate in a 10 days intensive photojournalism training course.

The course will focus on environmental photojournalism and will be conducted by Beth Wald, a renowned photographer and trainer, and winner of the Rowell Award 2006. A photo exhibition will be organised after the training presenting the best pictures produced by the course participants.

The training is supported by UNEP through funds received from the European Commission (EC) and the Government of Finland and will take place from 7 – 16 November 2006 at the CIJ centre located in Charai Kulup-e-askari, Sahsdarak, Kabul.

The training will be conducted in English with translation in Dari and Pashto available.
